Language in Camp

English

Aim of the Camp

The program is focused on environment, democracy and architecture- important features of Scandinavian society and traditions.

Visit to Parliament and local government, focus on democracy at work, discussions on international policy, visit to international companies, visit to Danish architectural museums and much more.

Deadline for application

April 1st 2023 - Participants will be accepted upon receipt and review of application.

Camp fee

DKK 2500 (Danish Crowns) equivalent to EUR €330, payment details will be shared once your application is approved. Participants pay travel expenses to and from Copenhagen (CPH) themselves. Recommend bringing about DKK 1500-2000 in allowance. Bring DKK to save local bank fees.

How to come

Accommodation

Participants stay together for all 14 days and are responsible for daily routines such as shopping, cooking, dishwashing and keeping the place tidy. You will have plenty of opportunities to develop relations and take responsibility.

The Camp is a scout's cottage like previous years.

All participants will sleep in the same dormitory,

and the accommodation is simple cottage style, however, all appliances are available.

The camp is located in Nærum, 20 kilometres north of Copenhagen with easy transport to the City.

Transport to and from Copenhagen

Nearest airport : CPH (Copenhagen Airport). You organize and pay for your own travel arrangements to and from Copenhagen.

Rotary organizes pick up at the local trainstation in Skodsborg. You will have to get from the airport by train to Skodsborg station, more information about this will be send out when applicants are confirmed.

Arrival MUST be :

AUGUST 12th from 8AM to 8PM.

You are welcome to contact Camp Managers for advice on travel arrangements.

During your stay, the following will be provided :
Accommodation, all food, local transport, entrance fees and WIFI in the Camp.

Departing MUST be :

AUGUST 26th 10AM

The Camp will be cleaned by the participants and closes at 10 AM on departure date.



What to bring

Check the weather on yr.no before you pack.

Its summer in Denmark, average temperatures 18-21 C. You may have rain, sun, wind.....evenings might be cold.

Bring a jacket, a light sweater, good walking shoes(no need for hiking boots), sandals or similar for the bathroom, swimsuit, towel(s), your choice of personal necessities etc.

You must bring your own sleeping bag (or similar). Bed and bedcovers are provided by the Camp.

A music instrument or other ways to entertain your group at the camp fire in the evenings is welcome. One of the first days you will introduce yourself, your family and your country. Bring whatever you feel could help you with the presentation. Photos on your PC/USB stick, your mascot.....
