Two-days excursions in the mountains of the regions, up to 2.500 mt in Val Biandino and to Monte San Primo (1.800 mt) will be the most important events during the two weeks. Preparation to them will be part of the program as well as medium-heavy trekking days; you will also visit Milan and Como. Definite programme will be issued by the end of March.

	Backpack for mountain tour Light wind jacket (waterproof) Long and short trekking pants Bathing costume Underwear for mountain conditions (about 2000 mt height) Waterproof hat or hood, light mountain mantle Sunglasses Sleeping bag is useless: we will provide a light bed bag
Eating	We will provide all meals: at lunchtime when walking it could be just a snack, dinner in the college refectory when at home or in mountain huts during excursions.
Guiding	Two or three experts will guide the group every day. You are asked to always stay in group, to follow your guides' suggestions and to abide by their instructions.
Payment	€200 Euro, via bank transfer, due at confirmation Bank details will follow directly to applicants
Arrival	Sunday July 2nd, 2023 (<u>in the afternoon</u>)
Departure	Saturday July 15th, 2023 Airport Milan Malpensa (preferred); Alternative Milan Linate; Railway Milan Central Station; Rotary Clubs will provide for welcome and escort service from/to airport/station.
