“Sailing with “Jensine” in the Danish South Sea”

during the period of **Tuesday 1st of August of to Monday 14th of August 2023**

The themes of the camp are: *See Southern Jutland (6 days)* and *Go sailing with Jensine (1 week)*.

Haderslev is a town in southern Denmark, located on the beautiful east coast of the peninsula Jutland. The first days you will stay at a Rotarian's home and see the Southern part of Denmark. After a few days the “summercampers” will go on board “Jensine of Haderslev”. This is the oldest wooden sailing ship in Denmark. The guests are the crew! A certified Captain and 1st Officer will be in charge on board.

A maximum of 11 young people no younger than 17 and no older than 21 can join this camp. You are invited to send one girl or one boy.

ACCOMODATION: At Rotarian homes before and after the sailing trip, as well as on board the ship “Jensine” (2nd week).

INSURANCE: The guests are expected to bring their own insurance (health, risks and accidents) that meets the requirements of Rotary International.

COSTS: The guests pay for their own trip to/from via Billund Airport (BLL) or Vojens Train Station in Southern Jutland, from where pick-up will be arranged. All other expenses are paid for by the Rotary Clubs, but we advise the guests to bring their own pocket money. Further a participation fee of DKK 1.000 (130 Euro) will be charged. This amount will be collected by IBAN-transfer to Haderslev Rotary Club, by Paypal to the “Camp Leader” (or in cash on the arrival day).
