Camp Details:

90% of the activity will be carried out in a tourist area using the Cultural Center of San Fernando de Maspalomas (or other facilities provided by the City Council), within the framework offered by the Maspalomas Summer University.

The conferences will begin on July 3, with participants being able to arrive on July 1 or 2, depending on the connection of their flights, and will end on July 7, with departure scheduled for July 9, 2023.

You will reside in a complex of Bungalows. Each one has a bedroom, bathroom and living room with sofa bed and kitchen, to be shared by three participants, with the sites being able to rotate every three days if they so wish. Always people of the same sex.

The complex has a swimming pool and its own leisure activities available to the participants.

Description	PROGRAM: VII INTERNATIONAL ROTARY CAMP MASPALOMAS, cultural recreational activity, 40% of the time takes place in conferences and workshops on Peace and Conflict Resolution, in its broadest aspect, speaking from international conflicts, as well as the use of social networks, conflicts schoolchildren and gender violence; the other 60% of the time is spent in sports activities, surfing, swimming pool, excursions, with a playful approach. ARRIVAL: At Gran Canaria airport (LPA), to choose between July 1 or 2, 2023. The Rotary Club of Maspalomas will arrange a pick-up and transfer to Bungalows Vistaflor both days at 6:00 pm. The collection will be carried out by a person who will stand with the Rotary logo waiting at the meeting point of Gran Canaria Airport (located next to the Spar supermarket). DEPARTURE: From the Bungalows Vistaflor there will be a bus available at 09:30am on July 9 to Gran Canaria airport. Outside these hours, any transfer from the airport to the Bungalows and vice versa must be carried out by the participant by his/her own means of transport.
