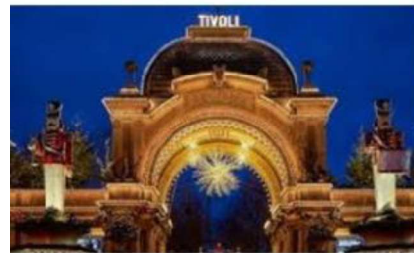

Camp ID Youth Camp Denmark 2024

Camp theme:

- Food and culture plus social relations
- Sightseeing, entertainment and social contacts
- to bring young people from various cultures and countries together
- to help young people better to understand each other and different cultures
- to create lasting friendships across borders - geographical as well as cultural borders
- to let the participants meet Danish culture and the Danish way of life



Dates July 27th - August 10th

Dronninglund RK July 27th – August 03th

Glostrup-Vestegnens RK August 03th – August 10th

Transfer between the two clubs will be taken care of.

Participants 1 girl and 1 boy from each country, max 20 participants

Age 15 to 18 years

Program A detailed programme will be sent later, but we can already now tell you, that during the first week, you are going to visit the **Danish countryside** and attractions in Northern Jutland and meeting Rotary families in their homes. During the second week the main theme will be: **Singing Gospel Choir** - and Culture. You will be taught to sing in a choir and there will be focus on your individual singing skills as well. Your singing expertise is not so important, but you need to have interest in singing in a choir. You will experience Danish food and culture, and you will have the opportunity to join a group of young people from around the world. There will, of course, be time



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for sightseeing in the Capital of Denmark. You will be accommodated with Danish host families.
