This is an outdoor camp where you can enjoy nature, the sea, sun, beach and new friends. The instructors are professionals who will take care of your learning step by step.

The participants will learn everything related to the sport of sailing, contact with nature and care for the environment.

They will learn to sail or improve their sailing skills. It will be combined with excursions and workshops within the community to learn more about Cantabria and its nature.

The young people will stay at the Isla de la Torre, located at the entrance of the bay in front of the Magdalena Palace and beach. A privileged place with excellent sea and wind conditions. These facilities are prepared for the stay in residence and full board.

The duration of the summer course is one week, from Sunday to Sunday, during the month of **July 7 to 14**.

There are **15 places** available, 2 of which could be for people with some kind of disability as long as this disability does not involve a wheelchair. It would be perfect for sensory disabilities. There is no limit of places based on nationalities, everyone is welcome.

The all-inclusive cost, minus the travel of the young people to the city of Santander, is €490 Euros.

Likewise, the federation has an insurance that is available for the course and is included in the cost.
