Participants	The first 10 registrants will be accepted, trying to pursue gender balance. The limit of 10 is mandatory. All participants must be able to swim.

Cost	€350 Euros (the cost includes food, accommodation, and transportation during the camp). The fee must be paid Net of bank commission.
Other Costs	Participants will have to pay for their trip to/from Lamezia Terme Airport (SUF), and should bring a reasonable amount of pocket money
Clothes	Casual clothes (Jacket for boys to be dressed during Rotary meetings), sneakers, swimsuit for pool/outdoor activities.
Insurance	Participants must be insured against illness, trip accidents and third-party liabilities according to Rotary International's recommendations.
