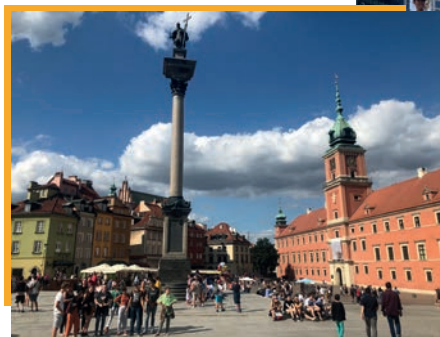

you will play a beach volleyball match admiring the panorama view of the Polish capital

you will explore the largest Polish city and discover public places and parks that are the most popular among its inhabitants

you will learn what Poznań is famous for and what is unique in the city

you will also get to enjoy Chopin's open air concert in the historical Łazienki park in central Warsaw

... and **you will** even get a taste of how to make traditional Poznań bread rolls (Rogale Marcińskie)

We are dedicated to making your trip as much fun as possible and taking back only positive memories of Poland.

You will also spend time with Polish families, who will host you in their homes, giving you the opportunity to deep dive into Polish culture, cuisine and relations.
