Optional laundry service, restaurant, supermarket, and swimming pool.

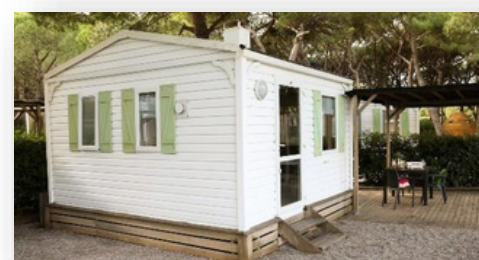

Return to Camping Tres Estrellas and accommodation.



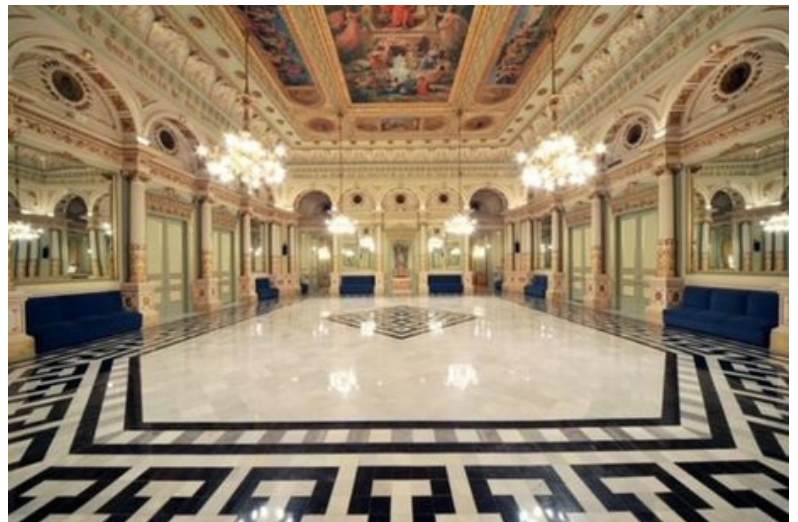

Visit the new Wax Museum of Barcelona opens its doors as a 21st century museum, but without losing its impressive architecture and history.

In the heart of the city, in the old Bank of Barcelona headquarters, the museum is now inhabited by some the most emblematic.



The Gran Teatre del Liceu, built in 1847, is a unique cultural facility in Barcelona and one of the most outstanding opera houses in Europe.

Located on La Rambla, it hosts great opera, ballet, and symphonic music productions every year.

The building was destroyed by fire in 1994 and reopened in 1999 after a splendid reconstruction.

Lunch at the **Can Cullaretes** restaurant, the oldest in Catalonia, dating from 1786 and the second oldest in Spain.

At the end of lunch afternoon free.

At 7:00 pm, in Plaza Cataluña, meeting to take the metro to Plaza España. From here, walk through the Montjuic mountain. to get to:

SALTS - Terrace Bar Montjuïc
Avinguda Miramar, 31 - 08038 Barcelona
With wonderful views of Barcelona
